Who are the WSET?

The WSET is the world's leading wine education organisation. Based in London it provides training in wine for professionals and consumers who wish to enhance their wine knowledge and gain a formal qualification. The courses and exams are recognised as the benchmark for wine education throughout the world.

LEVEL 2 INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATE

A 3 day course which offers a broad study of the world of wine and spirits. It provides a vocational qualification to those with some previous knowledge of wine but who need a reasonable professional level to support their job requirements. Also recommended for those people with a serious interest in wine.

LEVEL 3 ADVANCED CERTIFICATE

A five day course which provides a comprehensive understanding of the principal wines and spirits of the world and their commercial importance in the global market. It builds on the knowledge gained in the Level 2 Intermediate Certificate and provides an in-depth study of the main wine regions and a more detailed analytical approach to wine tasting. Suitable for the experienced wine professional or the serious wine enthusiast.
